How to create depth of field in your work.
The concept allows artists to control the viewer's focus, drawing attention to specific areas, while blurring others.

The day will start with a lesson instruction sheet on how to create depth of field in your work.

In photography and art, depth of field refers to the area in a composition that appears acceptably sharp and in focus. It's the range from the nearest to the farthest point that remains clearly defined. This concept allows artists to control the viewer's focus, drawing attention to specific areas while blurring others or using low contrast and high contrast.

Three small paintings will be done during the day.

Each student will be able to pick the three paintings they do from what I'll offer.

2 Quarter sheets size 140 cold press paper
You'll need all your watercolor basic supplies
2" wide masking tape
Exacto knife
