Why Monoprints?

Monotype printing is a simple, hands-on process where you apply paint or ink to a smooth surface and transfer it onto paper. Each impression is made only once, so no two prints are exactly alike. The technique naturally builds rich texture, layered color, and spontaneous marks — results that are often hard to achieve with a brush alone.

The process challenges you and strengthens your decision-making, offering new ways to approach color, composition, and layering without overworking. It's a direct, accessible way to recharge your studio practice and bring new ideas into your paintings, mixed media, or collage work — all without the need for a press or specialized equipment.
