Eligibility:

All Florida Artists and GCWS Members may enter up to two (2) Paintings

Entry and Fees:

A non-refundable fee of \$30 for GCWS members, and \$35 for non-members must accompany your entry. No changes can be made after the entry is received. No refunds will be made. All entries must be labeled on the back with the artist's name, phone number, title, value, and whether or not the painting is for sale. All sales will be handled through the museum and they will retain a 30% commission.

Media:

Entries are limited to wa<mark>ter media</mark> including any combination of watercolor, tempera, gouache, acrylic, casein, ink, charcoal, gesso, watercolor crayons, pencils, and pens, including metallics. Water-soluble oils and other similar substances are excluded. Collage: Watercolor collage is acceptable, but newspaper, magazine, book, or non-watercolor material cutouts will not be accepted.

Acceptable Surfaces;

Substrates created for water media include paper, clay-coated surfaces (Claybord, Aquabord, Ampersand), synthetic surfaces (Yupo, Tiger Rag), illustration boards, and flat watercolor canvas. Wood or canvas panels, gallery/museum wrapped canvas with no staples showing, or cradled board (must be 3/4" to 2" deep).

Presentation: (New) The minimum size of an unframed painting is 9"x12", or a total of 100sq in(H x W). Maximum length is 40" in any direction. Paintings must be framed unless mounted on cradle board. All work must be sturdily framed, wired, and ready for hanging. Sawtooth hangers are not permitted. All paintings not protected by plexiglass (preferred) or glass or must be varnished. Wood or canvas flat panels must be framed. Mats are optional and may be any color. All types of frames are permitted except those that are ornate or heavy. Work will be rejected if it does not comply and fees will NOT be refunded.

Originality:

All work must be the artist's own and not a copy of another artist's work and must be painted by a single artist (no collaborations or instructor painting). Work must have been completed within the last three (3) years and any submitted work must not have been previously displayed in a GCWS juried/judged show. NO NUDES ALLOWED
